Frits A.J. Muskiet graduated in Biochemistry, obtained his PhD by defending a thesis on catecholamine (metabolite) producing tumors and specialized in Clinical Chemistry, all at the Groningen University and the University Medical Center Groningen (UMCG). Until his retirement he held a permanent position as Clinical Chemist in the UMCG with activities in patient care, teaching and research. He was appointed Professor of Pathophysiology and Clinical Chemical Analysis in the School of Pharmacy at the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics, and Associate Professor at the Faculty of Medical Sciences. He is still active in research and teaching and has a broad research interest with activities in nutrition, life style in medicine, atherosclerosis, hemoglobinopathies/thalassemias, obstetrics/perinatology, psychiatry, evolutionary medicine and evidence based laboratory medicine. Until now he was an advisor of 33 PhD candidates and is (co)author of more than 280 PubMed registered publications.
